Architecture Virtual Taster Session

The University of Suffolk is offering a special practical virtual Architecture taster session on 4 May from 11.00am-12.30pm. Students will be able to access the session from home or if circumstances permit in a classroom group setting.

The aim of this session is to not only give students an insight into studying Architecture at the University of Suffolk but will encourage them to get hands-on with simple materials to explore light and its relationship to architectural structure. To make this possible we recommend that students have use of the following materials:

- 5 x A4 paper sheets
- 1 x recycled cardboard (e.g. cereal boxes or vegetable tray)
- 1 x recycled plastic tray (e.g. jaffa cakes or biscuit tray)
- 1x piece of sand paper
- Pencil
- Mobile phone
- Torch
- Scissors
- Mat
